8. (6) **Form of plaints, etc:-** All plaints, written Statements, applications affidavits, memoranda of appeal and other proceedings presented to the court, shall be written, type written or printed, fairly and legible on stamped paper or on substantial White A4 size paper(29.7 cm X 21 cm) having not less than 75 GSM with font - Times New Roman, font size 14, in 1.5 line spacing (for quotations and indents - font size 12 in single line spacing, with margin of 4 cm on left & right and 2 cm on top & bottom and separate sheets shall be stitched together book wise. The writing or printing may be on both sides of the paper, and numbers shall be expressed in figures.

"122. **Form of Appeals etc.:** - All petitions, applications, affidavits, memoranda of appeal or revision petitions and all proceedings presented to the High Court, shall be in English and shall be written or typewritten fairly and legibly on substantial white A4 size paper (29.7 cm X 21 cm) having not less than 75 GSM with font - Times New Roman, font size 14, in 1.5 line spacing (for quotations and indents - font size 12 in single line spacing, with margin of 4 cm on left & right and 2 cm on top & bottom and separate sheets shall be stitched together bookwise. The writing or printing may be on both sides of the paper and numbers shall be expressed in figures.

The memorandum of Criminal Appeal or the Criminal Revision Petition shall be accompanied by as many copies of the memorandum or petition on A4 plain paper as there are respondents to be served upon and another copy in addition for the Court record.
